- Treat everyone with dignity and courtesy (be kind)
- Respect the venue and rehearsal spaces
- Arrive at rehearsals on time and prepared
- Communicate with the Production Team if there are any issues
- Refrain from participating in any behaviour which may bring Hood & Dagger Productions into disrepute.

Hood & Dagger Productions will not tolerate discrimination, harassment, or bullying in any form. Members and volunteers are expected to respect the rights and dignity of others and treat others fairly and equally. If anyone feels they have experienced or are experiencing discrimination, bullying, or harassment, they should contact the Production Manager, Stage Manager, and/or Artistic Director. If that is not possible, they may contact a Board Member.
